



INDLS offers a Flexible Education

Our virtual educational environment means that we can adapt instructional methods and learning experiences to suit individual student needs. This allows for variations in how, when, and where learning occurs. At INDLS we understand that a one-size-fits-all approach is not effective for all students and families.

How does it work?

In order to meet the learning needs and family schedules of all students, our classes are held on a routine and consistent schedule Monday - Friday. Students in good academic standing can choose to attend live or complete the daily work individually with the assistance of the class recordings.

A Partnership

Students making use of our flexibility around attending live courses enter into a partnership with the school. This partnership means that the school provides all resources to students regardless of the mode of instruction and remains here to assist the child in live teacher-led courses on school days. The learning coach oversees their student's daily log-in and timely assignment completion. The student completes work on or before due dates and emails the teacher with any questions or needs.

Academic Good Standing

	Academics: Students performing academically have strong grades with no risk of failure (no grades below 70%).
	Attendance: Students with good attendance do not accumulate unexcused absences and report any absences due to sickness, family needs, or other situations to attendance@indls.net .
	Asking Questions: Students who ask questions and reach out to their teachers help to ensure their learning is meeting their personal needs. This can be done by attending class or emailing teachers.

Questions & Answers

- **Is there a certain time my student has to log in and complete work?**
 - We encourage your students to attend live classes any time they can, however, work can be done at any time of day.
 - Students should log in every school day.
- **What if we can't complete schoolwork on certain days?**
 - All school work and log-ins count at INDLS. If your student would like to work on a weekends instead of a weekday, that counts! If your student completes their work and submits it at any time during that week, that counts! If your student only works at 2 am, that counts (we are sorry for your sleep though!)
 - Students should maintain Academic Good Standing weekly (passing all classes at 70% or higher) by Sunday of each week.
- **How do we report an absence?**
 - Simply email Attendance@indls.net.
 - Report an absence on any school day your student is not attending or logging in.
- **How do we know if our student is in Academic Good Standing?**
 - **Grades** are available at all times in the parent or student account.
 - **Attendance** is sent to all students & learning coaches weekly, that email will tell you how many days the student has attended and how many excused or unexcused absences they have:

 - **Asking questions?** Encourage your student to reach out to their teachers about their learning via email if they are not attending live class.
- **My student has questions but is too shy to attend class connect.**
 - Email your teacher! They are always here for questions and will respond within 24 hours.
 - Class connect can be attended with or without a webcam, the use of the audio and video is optional for students except when required for state-proctored testing. The student always can chat directly with the teacher outside of the view of the other students as well as the group chat for peer-to-peer interaction if they choose.
